WALKING/BIKING POLICY

This form must be signed by parents and submitted prior to your child being granted permission to walk or ride a bicycle to and/or from class/camp.

Students must abide by the following rules when walking or riding a bicycle to and from any Cain Center for the Arts program. It is requested that each parent discuss these rules with their camper. Parents assume FULL responsibility and liability for the walker/rider's conduct, safety, bicycle, lock and helmet.

- Only children ages 10 and older may walk or ride bicycles to and from camp.
- Walkers must walk on sidewalks or designated walking paths to and from camp.
- Bicycles must have a lock and each rider is responsible for locking up his/her own bicycle.
- All bicycle riders are to have helmets or they will not be permitted to ride their bicycles to and from camp. Permitted riders without helmets will be requested to walk their bicycles home that day and return with a helmet the next day.
- Riders must follow bicycle safety rules, ride only one person on a bicycle at a time, and ride only in the bike lanes while riding on public streets.
- Walkers/bike riders must sign themselves in and/or out with Cain staff.
- Cain Center for the Arts cannot legally assume any RESPONSIBILITY OR LIABILITY in connection with a child's bicycle if it becomes lost, stolen, or damaged.

PARENT RELEASE

- I give permission for my child to walk and/or ride his/her bicycle to and from the Cornelius Arts Center.
- I understand that the roads around the Cornelius Arts Center are very busy and can be quite dangerous, especially at the beginning and end of class/camp.
- I have read and understand the Walking/Biking Policy and have discussed it with my child.
- I have reviewed my child's bicycle for roadworthiness and understand that it is my responsibility to keep the bike well-maintained.
- My child will always correctly wear an approved helmet when riding a bicycle to and from camp.
- I understand that bicycles, helmets, and locks are brought to camp at the owner's risk.
- I understand that if these rules are not followed my child may not be allowed to bring his/her bicycle to camp.
- I hereby waive and release Cain Center for the Arts, instructors, sponsors, volunteers, and any other persons associated with this program of all responsibility and liability of any nature whatsoever as it concerns any/all injuries, sickness, or damages which may occur to my child as a result of his/her walking and/or riding a bicycle to/from the Cornelius Arts Center.
